✓ When we are <u>facing ridicule</u>...

When Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became angry and was greatly incensed. He ridiculed the Jews. Nehemiah 4:1

- ... We will *pray*...
- ... And *persist*.
- ✓ When we are <u>facing threats</u>…

They all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and stir up trouble against it. Nehemiah 4:8-9

- ... We will keep on praying...
- ... And protect the vision God has given.
- ✓ When we are facing despair ...

Meanwhile, the people in Judah said, "The strength of the laborers is giving out, and there is so much rubble that we cannot rebuild the wall." Nehemiah 4:10 (NIV)
